

## CP1188 'Improvements to the use of the Half Hourly Aggregation Exception Report (D0235)'

## Redlined text based on BSCP503 'Half Hourly Data Aggregation' v9.0

Amend paragraph 1.d) in Section 4.3 of BSCP503 as follows:

d) Consumption Data Received for De-Energised Meter

If a SVA Metering System is de-energised, treat the consumption as zero, unless there is a nonzero consumption value, in which case this will be used in the aggregation process.

Record this data for reporting purposes.

Report the anomaly to the HHDC and Supplier.

Non-zero values recorded on the Effective From Date of an energisation status change, from energised to de-energised, should not be reported as an anomaly to the HHDC and Supplier.
