Changes to the Supplier Volume Allocation Meter Advance Reconciliation Requirements in the Code Subsidiary Documents.

Description of Change (mandatory by originator)

The Meter Advance Reconciliation (MAR) requirements for the Supplier Volume Allocation (SVA) market, as described in BSCP502 'Half Hourly Data Collection for SVA Metering Systems Registered in SMRS' are currently unclear. Amendments are therefore required to a number of Code Subsidiary Documents (CSD) to better define the MAR requirements.

Proposed Solution(s) (mandatory by originator)

Justification for Change (mandatory by originator)

A meeting between Half Hour Data Collectors (HHDCs), Meter Operator Agents (MOAs), Suppliers and ELEXON was held on 24 October 2002 to discuss MAR requirements. ELEXON, following consultation with the group contacted Meter manufacturers to establish what cumulative register readings are remotely retrieved by the HHDC on interrogation of integral Outstations. The conclusions reached are that the time of the 'electronic register' reading relates to when interrogation takes place, ie. current time and there is no difference in the readings of the 'internal electronic register' and the Meter register, ie. the register displayed on the front of the Meter.

The proposed changes to the CSDs take account of feedback received from Meter manufacturers and the conclusions of the group and will mean that the obligations placed on Suppliers via their HHDCs with respect to MARs, are better defined.
