Purpose Review of BSC Configurable Items amended for P367

What is the purpose of this Circular?

We sent out a Release circular on 18 February 2019, notifying the initial scope of the June 2019 Release.

Approved Modification <u>P367</u> ("Removal of obsolete Supplemental Balancing Reserve (SBR) and Demand Side Balancing Reserve (DSBR) arrangements") will be implemented as part of this Release.

This circular invites the BSC Parties to review the proposed changes to the BSC Configurable Items (CIs). The changes are redlined for your review.

What's new for P367?

P367 will remove the now obsolete Supplemental Balancing Reserve (SBR) and Demand Side Balancing Reserve (DSBR) arrangements.

The scope of this circular is limited to review of the BSC CIs amended for P367. The amended BSC Sections were approved during the Modification process. The other documents such as the Imbalance Pricing Guidance Note and Section T Simple Guide will be updated and reviewed internally within ELEXON and published on the implementation date.

Who is impacted by P367?

There are no impacts on the BSC Parties and Party Agents. There are no changes to the BSC Systems.

Is there anything else to note?

These CIs have P369 changes applied to them. These changes were sent out for your review late last year and approved by the Panel on 13 December 2019.

<u>P369</u> ("National Grid Legal Separation changes to BSC") will be implemented as part of the <u>March 2019 Standalone</u> Release on 29 March 2019.
