

WIDER MARKET ACCESS AND TERRE STANDALONE RELEASE CIRCULAR – IDD UPDATE

Purpose	This circular notifies interested parties of the final draft versions of the BSC Configurable Items amended for Project TERRE, which includes the IDD Spreadsheets.

What is the purpose of this Circular?

The purpose of this circular is to notify interested parties of the latest versions of the BSC Configurable Items (CIs) that we are amending under CP1517 to give full effect to P344 Final Implementation.

Background

On 17 May 2019, ELEXON BSC Change issued Change Proposal [CP1517](#) for industry consultation as part of [Change Proposal Circular CPC00794](#). The BSC Release team followed up with an email advising interested parties that **Draft E** of the NETA Interface Definition Document (IDD) Part 1 and 2, which were equivalent to the initial CP1517 versions, had been uploaded onto the [GB Wider Access and Terre Implementation Guidance](#)

Following the conclusion of the industry consultation, ELEXON made further amendments to some of the BSC CIs to address comments received from the consultation and to provide additional information for the benefit of the industry.

Consequently, ELEXON issued CP1517 for a second industry consultation on 9 July 2019 through [CPC CPC00795](#). We uploaded the new versions of the NETA IDD Part 1 and 2 onto the P344 Implementation Guidance: Project TERRE and Wider Access web page as **Draft F**. We received responses from the second consultation, which required further amendments to some of the BSC CIs, including the NETA IDD Part 1 and Part 2 spreadsheets.

Where can I find details of the amendments to the BSC CIs?

As we have published interim versions of the Interface Definition and Design (IDD) Spreadsheets for information on the [GB Wider Access and TERRE Implementation Guidance](#) web page since April 2019, we have also published the latest versions of the IDD Spreadsheets, which we will present to the Imbalance Settlement Group (ISG) for approval, on this page as "**Draft G**".

Worksheet	Row Affected	Data Group	Description of Change
NETA IDD Part 1 SAA worksheet	648-651 888-891	SQH	In the SAA-I014, sub-flows 1 and 4, the data items in the System Quarter Hour Data (SQH) group need to be moved down a level (from L3 to L4). This is correcting a manifest error: the structure of the IDD requires that data items are always one level below the record that contains them.
NETA IDD Part 2 Stage 2 worksheet	134-136	PAC	The format of three data items in the Settlement Administration Agent (SAA)-I052 sent by Supplier Volume Allocation Agent (SVAA) has been changed from Boolean (i.e. the valid set was 'T' and 'F'), to Text (5) (where the valid set is 'True' and 'False') to enable SAA to load the SAA-I052.

When will we request approval of the BSC CIs amended for CP1517?

We will request approval of the relevant BSC CIs from the ISG on 20 August and/or the Supplier Volume Allocation Group on 3 September 2019, as required by the BSC Baseline Statement.

What else do I need to know?

- **BMRS API User Guide:** The TERRE changes impact the BMRS APIs and DataPush. These changes have been documented within the BMRS API User guide. On 11 July, Version 2.1 of the BMRS API User Guide was made available for review.

Following the responses from the second industry consultation for CP1517, [Version 2.2 of the BMRS API User Guide](#) is now available to reflect changes to the NETA IDs. Please use this version instead.

- **Testing the Project TERRE and wider Balancing Mechanism Access software:** ELEXON has confirmed the arrangements for testing the software platform to allow wider access to the GB Balancing Mechanism (BM) and participation in Project TERRE. The test strategy document can be found [here](#)
